Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Do others recognize us as God’s children?" Do others recognize us as Christians because they see Christ in us? Because we act as Christ acted? Or that we love as Christ loved? From the early days of the Church, even until today, the Most Holy Trinity has been one of the greatest and most inexplicable mysteries of our Catholic faith. Throughout this time religious scholars and theologians have tried to explain how God could truly be One in three Persons. However, their words and images always fall short, when it comes to expressing in detail the triune nature of God. We can say that the family represents the unity of the trinity in the world we live in. God chose a family as a sacred symbol of love, a love that is so special that a man and woman will leave their parents and become one. At the moment of conception God places the eternal soul of that being into reality. We now have a trinity in the making; man, woman, and God. The union that exists between the three persons in God is similar to the union God has in mind for every husband, wife, and child. God the Father loves God the Son with all his being. God the Son loves God the Father back with all his being. The love is so deep and strong that it becomes one; it is a living image of their love, a living spirit of their love. We call it the Holy Spirit. When a husband loves his wife with all his heart and soul, and the wife loves her husband with all her heart and soul, the result is a living sign of their love, "A Child". May our celebration nurture within each of us the desire to create human relationships that imitate as much as possible, the love shared by the **Father** who created us, the **Son** who redeemed us, and the **Holy Spirit** who sanctifies us.

2017-2018 School Year

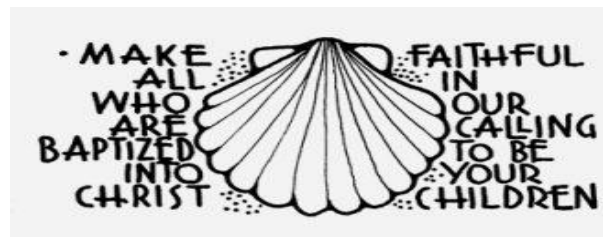
