Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The Apostles began the first novena as Jesus ascended into heaven and they prayed for nine days until the Holy Spirit descended upon them. A **novena** is an act of religious pious devotion originating in ancient Christianity, often consisting of private or public prayers repeated for nine successive days in belief of obtaining special intercessory graces. **Novenas** are most often prayed by members of the Roman Catholic Church, as well as by communicants of the Anglican Church, Eastern Orthodox Church and Lutheran Church. There are several novenas dedicated to Our Blessed Mother Mary as well as to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, Saints and Special novenas such as Divine Mercy, Ascension, Assumption and Holy Family... I would invite you all to bring prayer into your families in a special way to teach our children the need to pray daily. We never walk alone; Jesus assures us that we would never walk alone. He assured us through the Apostles that *"The Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything."* May daily prayer fill our homes with God's love.
