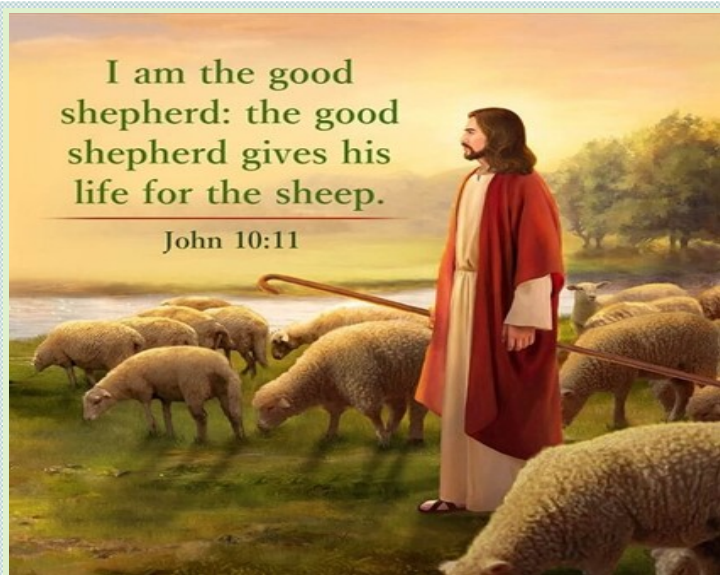


Fourth Sunday of Easter

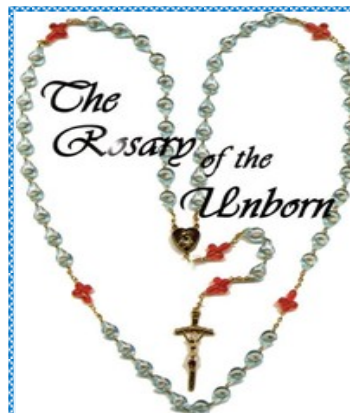
