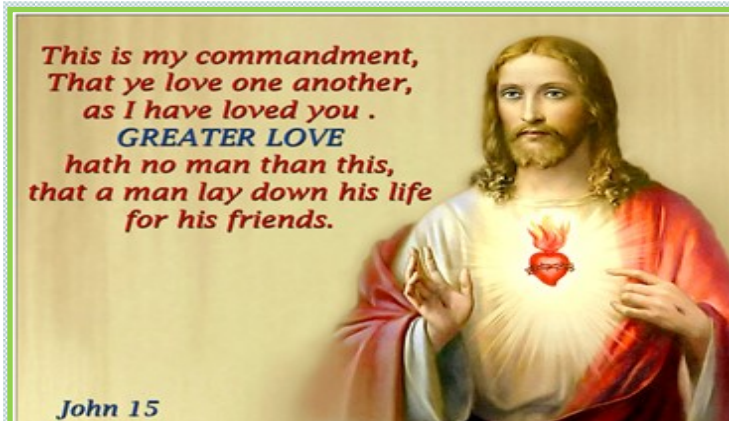


Sixth Sunday of Easter
