

# St. Mary's Catholic School Catholic Education in the Classical Tradition

Catholic Classical education will cultivate our students' love for the True, the Beautiful, and the Good - and help each child ultimately discover the Divine nature and order of all things. Through wonder and awe, our students will be guided ever closer to Our Creator, and thus recognize the glory of the Incarnation of Jesus Christ and our resulting salvation.

Catholic Classical Education is an educational approach rooted in the medieval concept of the *Trivium* (Latin for "three ways"). Each element of the Trivium (grammar, logic, and rhetoric) is viewed as subjects, stages of development, teaching methodologies, and tools for learning. A student who has mastered the tools will be able to think and learn for themselves and thus be able to master any subject they approach.

We will begin our vision with History and Language Arts in the Fall of 2021 moving on to Nature Studies and Math in the Fall of 2022. Because our Catholic Identity permeates all areas of our curriculum, Religion will transition naturally with each subject. We are excited to be part of history at St. Mary's Catholic School.


