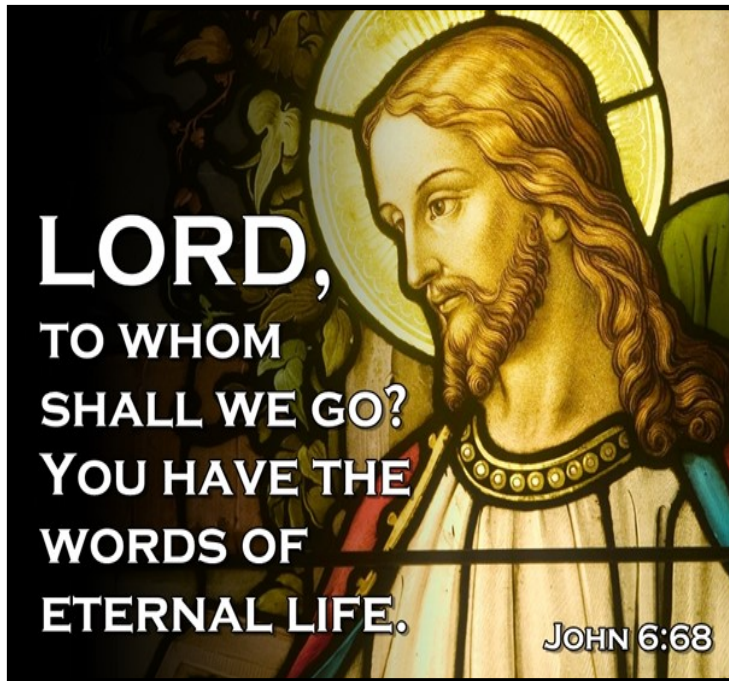

Wednesday, September 8th at 6:30pm in the O'Reilly Building we will have an Open House and Registration event. Come out and register your student for classes.

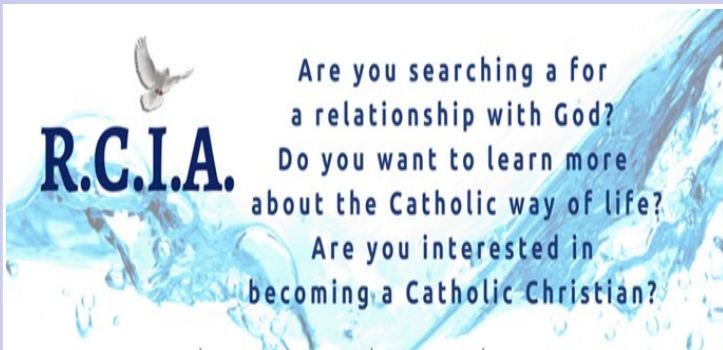


FALCONS CORNER
