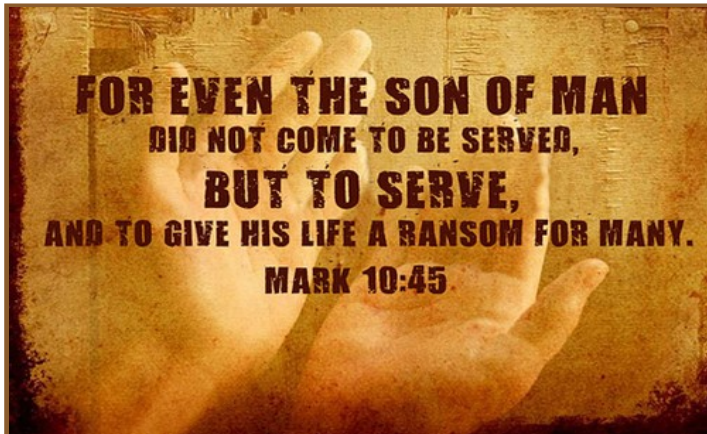


Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time
