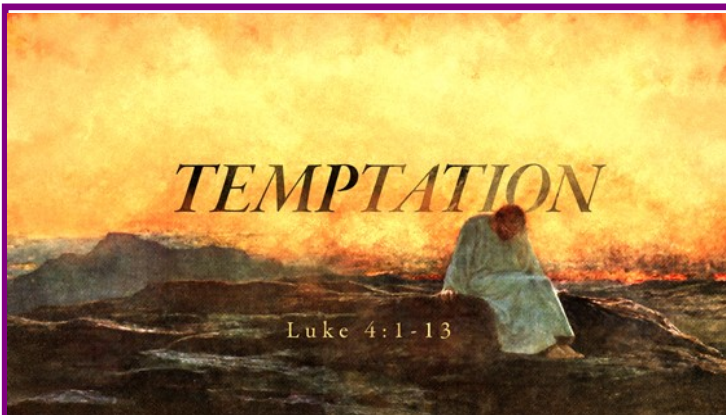


First Sunday of Lent

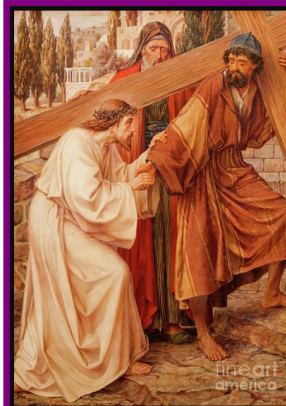
