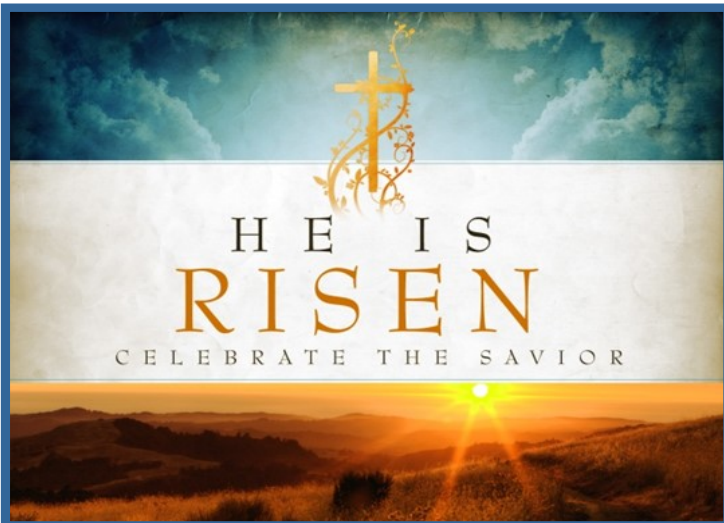


Easter Sunday Resurrection of the Lord
