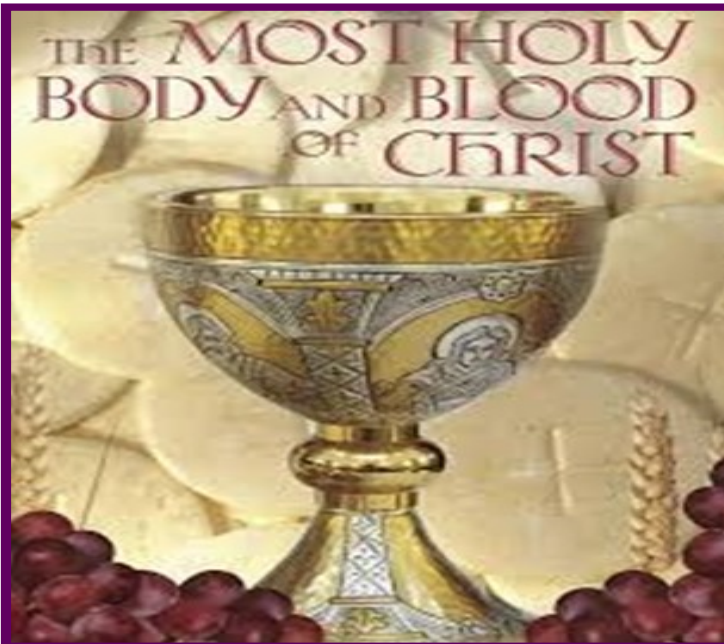


The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

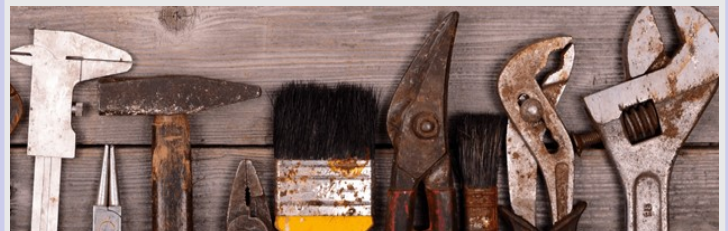

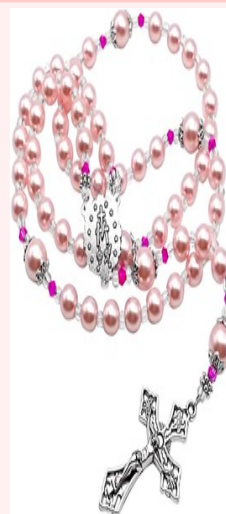
