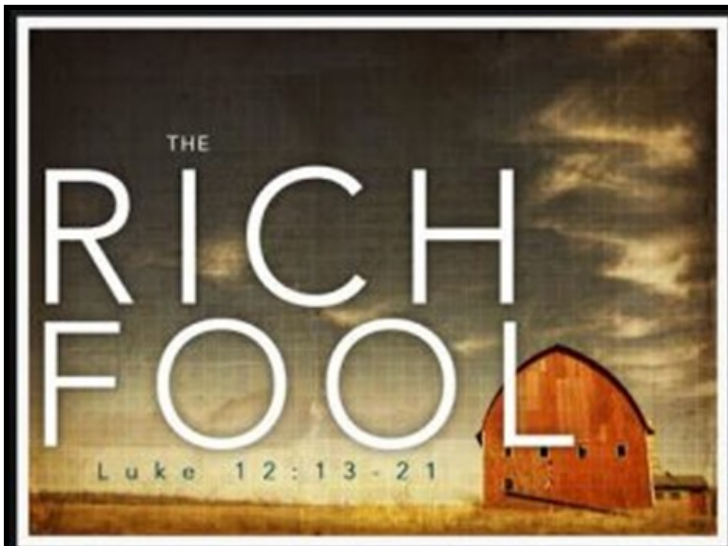


Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
