On Aug. 15, the feast of the **Assumption of Mary**, all are invited to spend the day reflecting on this beautiful solemnity of Mary, what her Assumption means and how we are called to follow Jesus. Brian Egan, Cedarbrake director, and Father Harry Dean, the new Cedarbrake chaplain will present this day. The day, from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., will include Mass and lunch. Cost is \$45.

Back by popular demand, Fr. Gilberto Cavazos-Gonzalez, OFM, returns to Cedarbrake Aug. 19-21 to present a contemporary understanding of **St. Bonaventure's Triple Way**. For hundreds of years, Christian writers spoke of drawing closer to God through purgation, illumination and union. This retreat will explore the triple movement of Christian discipleship and its implications for those seeking a deeper relationship with Jesus. Fr. Gilberto is a spirituality professor at the Catholic Theological Union in Chicago. The cost is \$270 for a private room and \$230 for a shared room.
