



Ethics and Integrity in Ministry (EIM)

Diocese of Austin

The EIM Office is converting the EIM database and training programs to VIRTUS products over the next few months. To make the data conversion process as smooth and accurate as possible:

There will be no EIM Workshops held between November 16 and early January 2023

NEW APPLICANTS: If you are new to ministry in the Diocese of Austin and wish to serve between now and early January, 2023, you must submit an EIM Application for Ministry (austindiocese.org/ application) BY OCTOBER 31, and attend an inperson EIM Workshop (austindiocese.org/initial-eimtraining) BY NOVEMBER 15.

CURRENT/EXISTING APPLICANTS: If you will serve in ministry between now and the end of the calendar year, you must be compliant through the end of the year by NOVEMBER 15.


If you need to update/renew your compliance, online EIM training is available at (austindiocese.org/ onlineeimtraining) until end of day November 15 (you do not need to login to your EIM account to complete the online EIM training).
