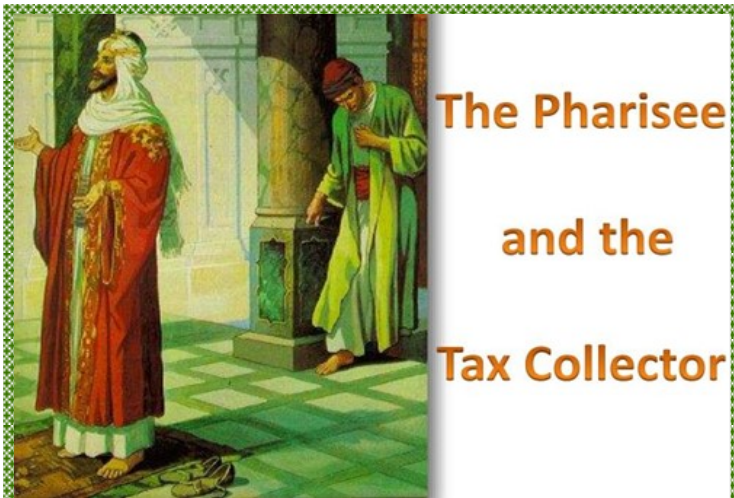

**Donation Boxes** are located at each exit of the Church or in the Parish Office.

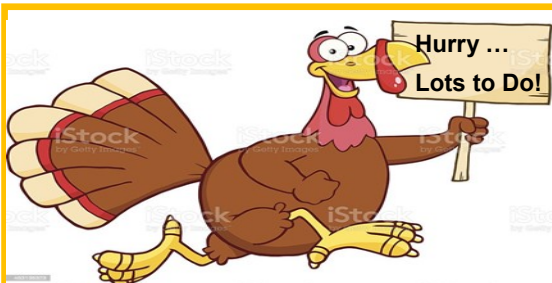

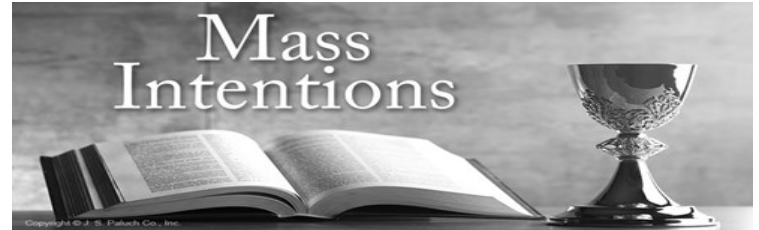
