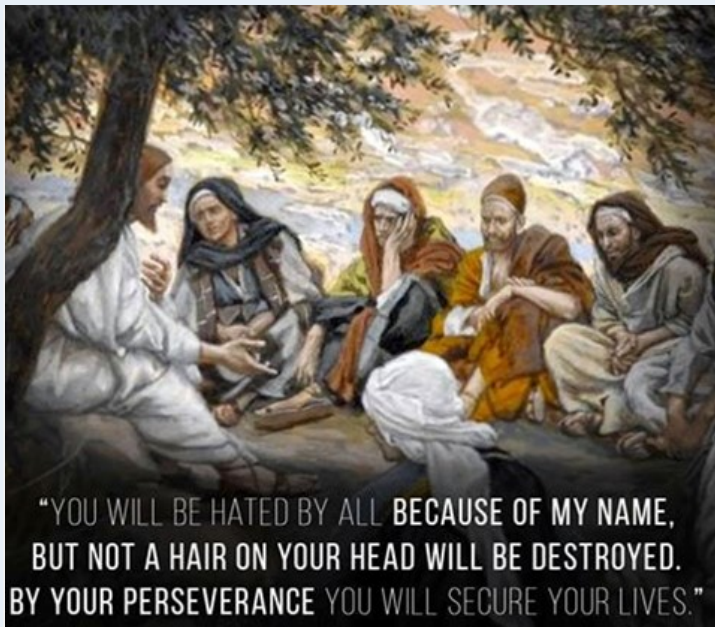


Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time

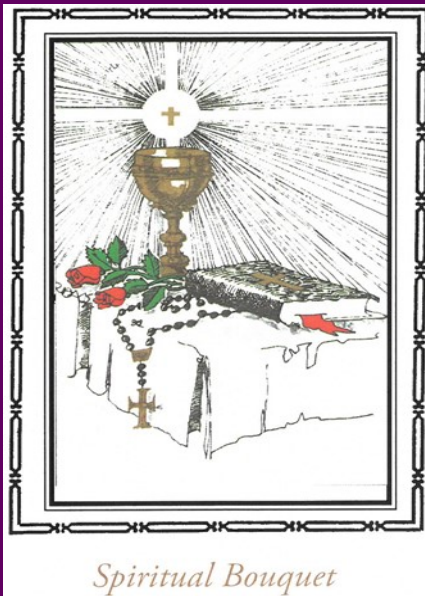

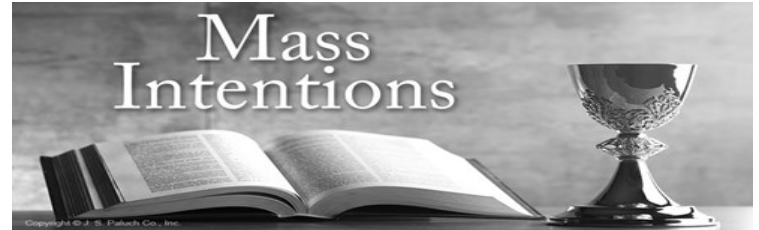
