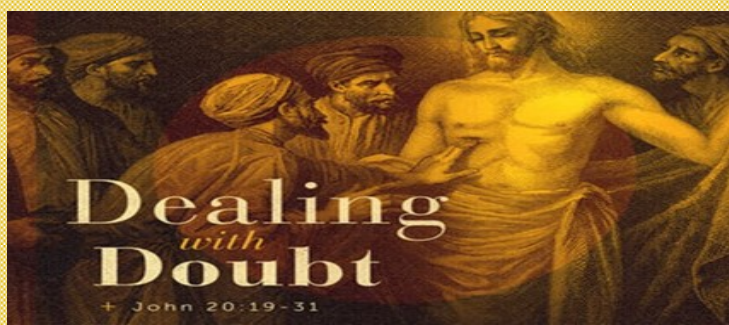


Sunday of Divine Mercy
