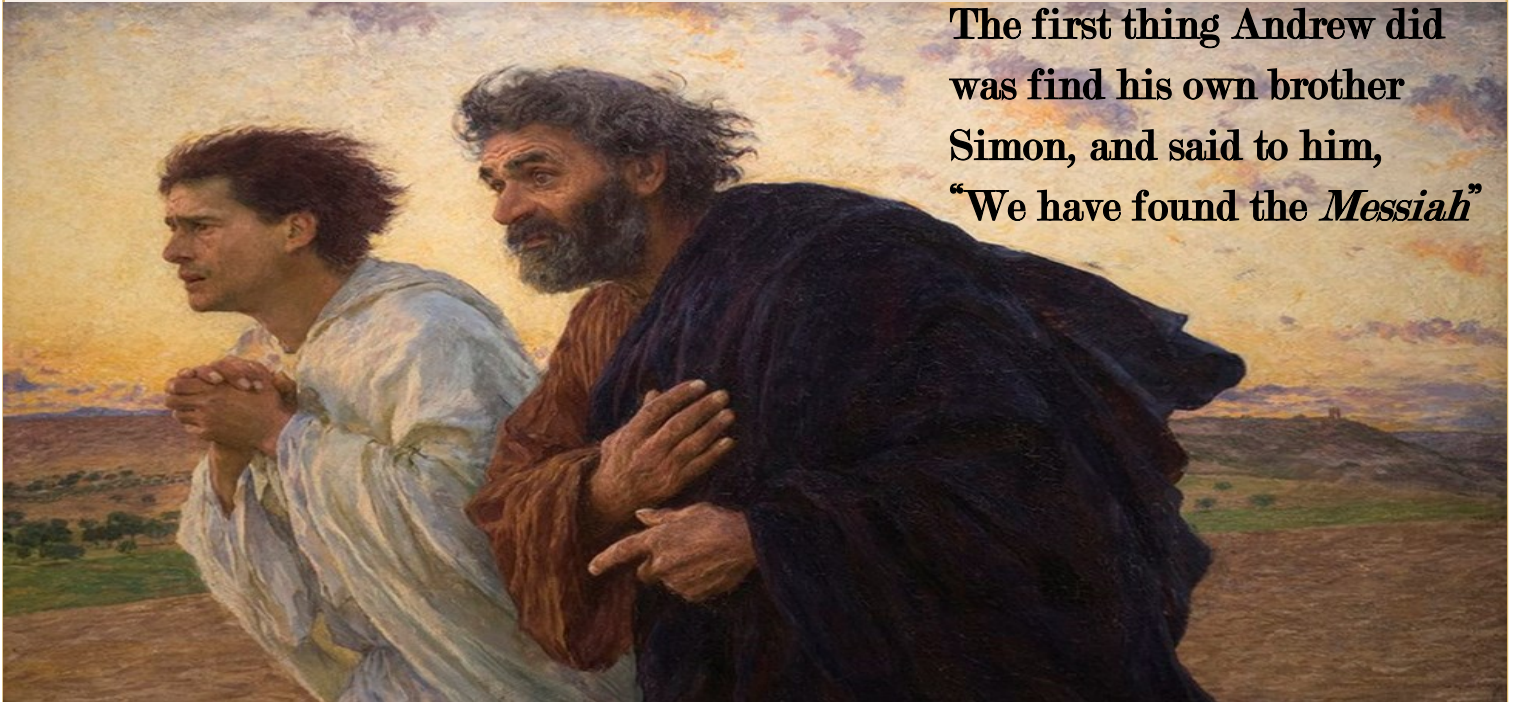


**SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME****JANUARY 14**

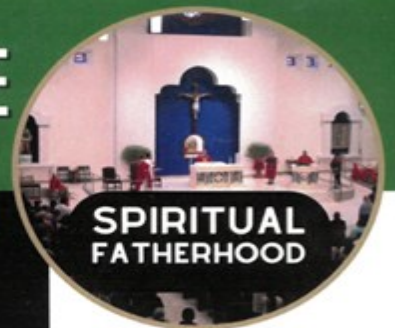

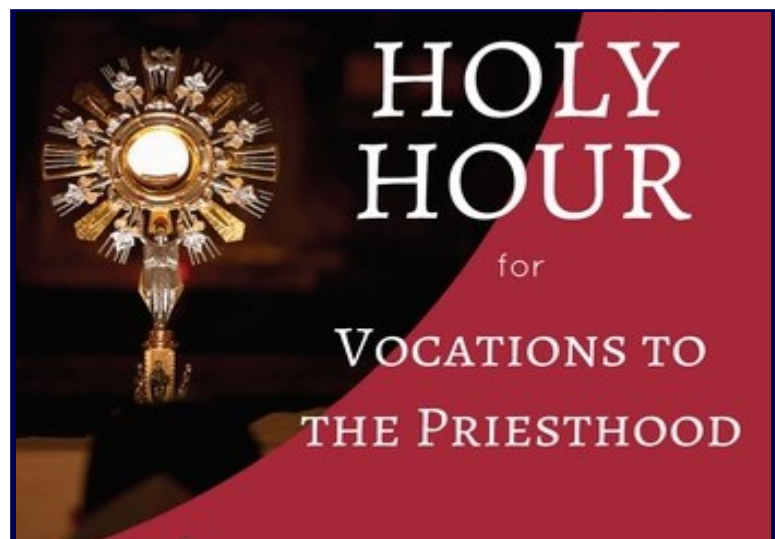
