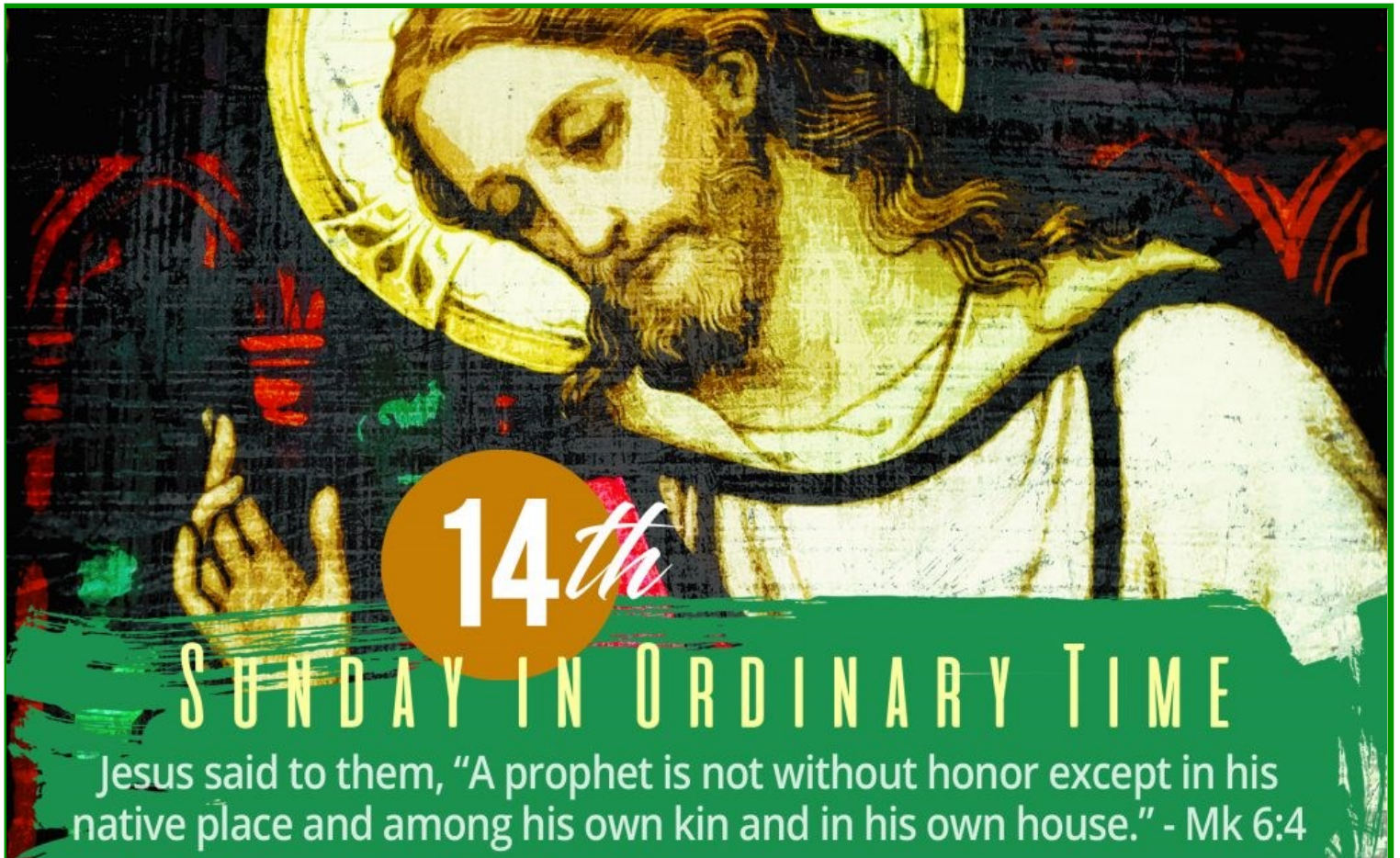


Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Have we hardened our hearts to God's voice and presence like those of old?
