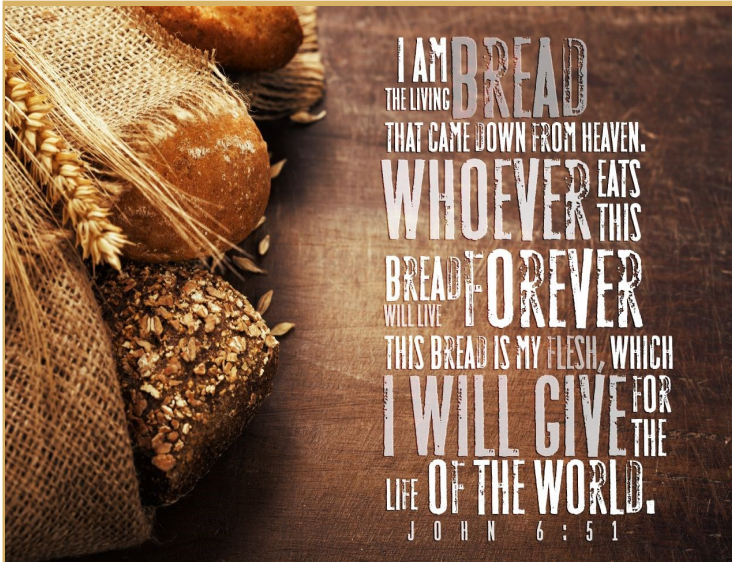


Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

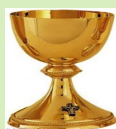
