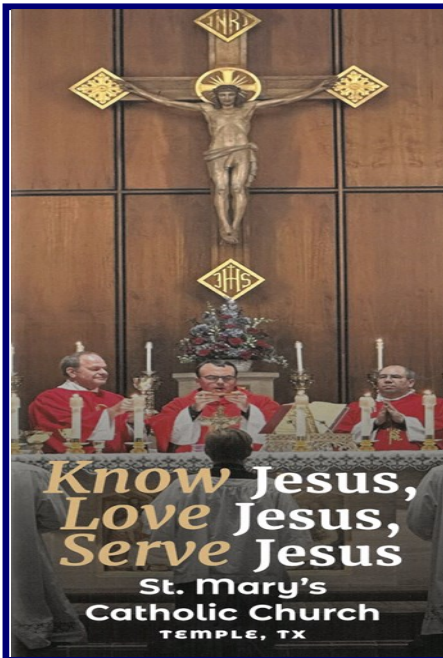
### “Know Jesus, Love Jesus, Serve Jesus” Program


