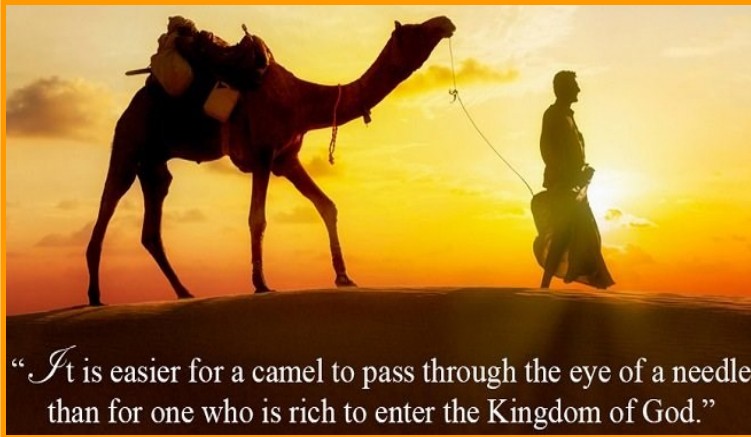


# Twenty-eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time



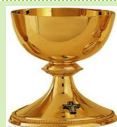

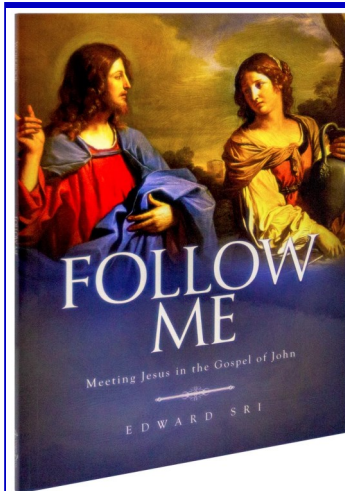

The Knights of Columbus 4th Degree reminds you to make your vote count this year!
