### PASTORAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES - JUNE 2025

Synopsis of Pastoral Council Meeting (June 17, 2025)

The Pastoral Council meeting began with prayer and a brief review of the previous meeting, along with a discussion about current ministries. Pastoral Council is scheduled to meet July 22nd, 2025.

#### **Key Discussion Points:**

- **Post-Rescue Project Outreach:**Ideas included developing a process to welcome newcomers via phone or online registration, emailing new parishioners using Flocknote filters, and possibly offering welcome gifts.
- Online Giving System: Some issues with the current system were discussed as well as possible alternatives. Fr. Will plans to look into this more fully.
- Increased Offertory Program: Set to run again from August 24th–31st with a structured rollout over four Masses. A new slogan is needed to support this campaign.
- Faith Formation Initiatives: Emphasis on reaching working adults with programs like *That Man Is You!* and a potential quarterly or semi-annual Women's Bible Study. It was proposed to run the Rescue Project biannually and hold four missions each year (Advent, Lent, summer, and fall).
- Quinceañera Guidelines: Updated to align with those of local parishes.

#### **Parish Life Reflections:**

Members noted great community strength and volunteer support during events. Mass attendance has held steady going into the summer months.






