

PASTORAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES - JUNE 2025

Synopsis of Pastoral Council Meeting Minutes (July 22, 2025)

The meeting opened with a prayer and proceeded with follow-ups from the prior session. The following agenda items were discussed:

Major Agenda Items:

- **RCIA Reformat**: A new 4-year formation plan proposed by Deacon Chris is under consideration, potentially incorporating the *National Directory for Catechesis*.
- **Rescue Project**:Currently drawing strong participation from families and adults. The council discussed doing the Rescue Project again for **Lent 2026**.
- Master Planning: A firm from Waco has been selected to conduct a space utilization analysis for the church campus.
- Increased Offertory Program: Scheduled for rollout with a homily on August 23 and a commitment appeal on August 30, with a target of 6% increase in the offertory.
- Advent Mission: Planned for **December 12th–13th**, featuring an evening gathering for families and a morning session for adult faith formation.
- Pastoral Council Recruitment:

Nominations for new members will open in August, with a parish-wide announcement.
